

After 65 years of educating students at Lutheran High School and Milwaukee Lutheran High School, Martin Luther High School was established to serve students in the Greendale area.

The sports fields were finalized and students were invited to participate on 4 athletic teams: football, basketball, wrestling and cheerleading.

Enrollment hit 500 students with 13 athletic teams, 8 vocal and instrumental groups, and 2 annual theater productions. The football field was rededicated as Gene Schneider Field, in honor of an original Martin Luther teacher, athletic director, and football coach.

The press box and bleachers at Gene Schneider Field were completed, increasing the seating capacity tenfold.

In response to the growing number of international students attending Martin Luther, a dorm was built to house up to 72 students from around the world.

HONORS ACADEMY


The Honors Academy at Martin Luther enhances the high school academic experience for its students.

Inspired by the rich academic foundation laid by Spartan alumni, the Honors Academy creates space for academic experiences and expectations beyond those required of all Martin Luther students.

The Martin Luther College Prep curriculum is a robust program designed to support every student. With 26 available AP and dual-credit courses, along with a dedicated staff focused on building relationships and fostering educational exploration, students are empowered to set and achieve individualized goals. The Honors Academy, however, goes further, challenging students to reach their maximum academic potential.



JOCELYN'S STORY

In elementary and middle school, Jocelyn Provost was reserved and shy. The child of a first-generation immigrant, she grew up with minimal talk of religion or Jesus. She confided, "I didn't know who I was."

After touring multiple options for high school, Jocelyn heard about Martin Luther and immediately felt she needed to see what the school was about. "I know now that God was telling me, 'This is where you need to be, Jocelyn."

Walking into the first day of school, Jocelyn didn't know anyone but was struck by how happy and friendly the staff and students were. She'd never experienced a place where everyone was so excited to talk to her and show her around.

During the first two years at ML, Jocelyn kept to herself and didn't get involved much, but everything changed during junior year when she decided to join tennis. "That's where I made the biggest progress in my faith journey." She met many new friends who opened her up to the idea that God is real. "I saw this thing in them that I call the 'Jesus Glow.' It's seeing someone so happy and peaceful. You could see that they had a sense of purpose. They knew who they were, and I wanted that for myself."

Jocelyn wanted to know what her friends knew, learn what they were learning, and apply it to her life. She started listening intently in chapel, reading her Bible, and reflecting on what she read. "I started to feel a sense of peace compared to the anxiety I always felt. I felt what I now know is love."

One evening, she was praying in her room at home and remembers saying, "Jesus, I surrender my life to you, and the rest of it is your will." Afterward, Jocelyn described feeling a sense of relief, like a weight was lifted off her shoulders, and she could breathe again.

"I learn something new about God every day at Martin Luther. I feel that ML has set me up with a great foundation for my faith, and I hope it continues growing every day! I was meant to be here, and I'm so grateful I came to Martin Luther."
